I sent a follow-up email last week with the attached letter that explains what I thought was missing in the WRSA and other water rights documentation included with the Dockton SWSMP.

The WRSA form that you sent was found in the documentation that I reviewed and was included in my review.

Also, I have since found an additional permit not listed for wells located uphill from Dockton Springs (G1-28771). This permit is in the development phase but our office does not show that construction has been completed. Dockton was sent a reminder in October 2022 stating that the permit development plan is currently out of compliance. I recommend that this situation be corrected.

The quantities authorized under permit G1-28771 are 144 gpm and 140.8 ac-ft/yr. Both quantities are issued as non-additive and are intended to operate as supplemental to water rights issued or claimed for Dockton Springs (S01).

Documentation for G1-28771 and the other water rights listed in my comment letter can found on the <u>Ecology Water Right Search Site</u>. Please note that when using the search, the omission of dashes and asterisks can result in a failure to find records. Table 2 in my letter provides the correct syntax for water right records in searches.

Please note that the WRSA must include all water rights certificates, permits and claims held by the water system. As mentioned in the comment letter, water rights not listed in the SWSMP and/or the WASA may be interpreted as evidence of abandonment. It is important however to keep in mind that water rights that exceed the capacity of the source should be relied upon for planning purposes (this may be the case for water rights issued or claimed for Dockton Springs).
